



Band Uniform Washing Instructions

PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY...

(While this is an easy task, proper care must be taken to protect our uniforms*)

Some helpful hints:

- Please wash the jackets separate from the bib-pants.
- Please leave all the gauntlets in their bags along with any gloves that may be in the bags. If you are washing for a tuba player, please **DO** remove the beret that is in the gauntlet bags. The berets do **NOT** get machine-washed.

Ensure that the toggle on the gauntlet bag is pushed down against the bag to prevent items from falling out.

- **Please use COLD WATER and the normal amount of regular non-chlorine household laundry detergent. NO BLEACH and NO FABRIC SOFTENER or DRYER SHEETS. It is ok to treat any stains you see with Shout or Spray & Wash.**
- **DO NOT SOAK UNIFORMS** as this causes damage to the buttons.
- After washing **IMMEDIATELY** remove the uniform from the washer and start in the dryer. Use **LOW HEAT/COOL** dryer setting and remove and hang properly when dry.
- Please return the clean uniform to the uniform room in the band hall to the correct rack. Students will know which rack to use.

PLEASE RETURN THE UNIFORMS TO THE BAND HALL BY:

***You may be responsible for the repair or replacement of any damages to the uniform caused by improper washing.**
